- Meeting Notes – The meeting notes from the March 2016 meeting were approved.
- Krakken – The Arts Commission discussed and furthered the idea of building a bench around the sculpture. The commission felt that a combination of wood and metal will complement the piece. The bench will need to be custom made.
- Autumn Wind Sculpture – Architectural Elements have discovered that one of their sources was having challenges bending the steel to form the curves of the sculpture. They have contacted two other companies and are sampling their work to make sure they can go forward. Once they determine that it can be done, they will have it shaped.
- Barringtons – The sculpture has been completed. Awaiting installation.
- Driftwood Day – The Commission discussed the need to start advertising for the event. Need photos to update the poster. Commission Skip will update the poster with the dates etc. The Commission decided to do 1000 postcards this year. Also discussed getting the message on the reader board at Beeksma Park. The Commission determined that the treatment plant will not impact the event since it will be on the west side this year.
- Windjammer Park – Commissioner Skip provided an update on the Community Advisory Group meeting on the park improvements and the various phases that are proposed. The Arts Commission was curious on the funding source for the project. Currently Phase 1 will be explored for implementation since it is mainly related to the impacts of the construction. The Arts Commission expressed interest in being involved.
