



City of Oak Harbor Non-Discrimination Statement

Title VI Compliance Civil Rights

The City of Oak Harbor hereby gives public notice of its policy to assure full compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and related amendments, statues and regulations in all Federally funded programs and activities. Title VI requires that no person in the United States of America shall, on the grounds of race, color, or national origin, be excluded from the participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be otherwise subjected to discrimination under any program or activity for which the City of Oak Harbor has received Federal financial assistance.

Any person, individually or as a member of any specific class of persons, who believes that they have been subjected to discrimination on the basis of race, color, or national origin may file a complaint with the City of Oak Harbor. A complaint must be filed within 180 days after the date of the alleged discrimination. Discrimination Complaint Forms may be obtained at no cost to the complainant by calling (360) 279-4500.
