


The City of Oak Harbor's Centennial Oak Grove is a Garry oak grove established at the intersection of State Route 20 and Fakkema Road. It is a legacy project started in 2015 in celebration of our City's 100<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of incorporation. It was created through teamwork, utilizing City resources, volunteers and donations. The initial planting consisted of 100 saplings planted in the Fall of 2015, which was quickly followed by the planting of 237 seedlings in early 2016.

The initial planting phases of Garry oak saplings and seedlings have been well received by the Community, fostering interest and support of the grove. Many citizens and visitors have expressed the pleasure in being able to see the trees sprout buds and leaf out. Citizens have also been inquiring as to how they can continue to support the project.

Since the 100 saplings have been planted, direct sponsorship of a sapling is not currently an option. However, donations and volunteers are still needed. The third phase of planting is planned for Fall of the 2016. This phase will include the planting of approximately 60 seedlings and will need materials and volunteer labor.

While the necessary seedlings have already been donated, financial donations will be used to acquire the necessary materials such as tree tubes, soil amendments, stakes, mulch, and fencing. Direct donation of these materials is also welcome.



Volunteers will be needed for the third phase and other future phases. If you are interested in volunteering at the grove, your name and contact information can be placed on a contact list (just check the box at the bottom of the form). As future volunteer work projects are scheduled, the City will contact those on the list to organize volunteer work groups.
