

RESOLUTION 18-28

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF OAK HARBOR AUTHORIZING THE ACQUISITION OF THE SCULPTURE PIECES KNOWN AS THE "JOSEPH KINNEBREW SCULPTURE COLLECTION".

WHEREAS, the City finds that public artistic expression of all kinds enhances the historical, cultural, economic, educational and social life of the community and benefits the health and welfare of the City's residents; and

WHEREAS, the City finds it appropriate, necessary, and desirable to promote and support public experiences of the visual arts and artistic disciplines for the good of the citizens of Oak Harbor; and

WHEREAS, the City of Oak Harbor Arts Commission has a vision to work towards the creation of a sculpture park in Oak Harbor to serve as a public display of art and a local attraction; and

WHEREAS, the City of Oak Harbor Arts Commission has been working to obtain a set of pieces created by sculptor Joseph Kinnebrew and envisions using these pieces as the foundation for a sculpture park;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Oak Harbor Washington, that the City Council authorizes the acquisition of the "Joseph Kinnebrew Sculpture Collection", in the amount of \$19,566.00, to be paid from the Art Acquisition and Maintenance Fund.
