

## Boat Insurance

As a reminder, proof of insurance in the amount of \$300,000 of liability insurance is required as a condition of your moorage contract.



*Make sure your insurance is up to date.*

Stephanie is in the process of auditing all tenant files and has found that some people do not have the proper insurance documentation on file.

In some cases we found that the proof of insurance card has been provided, however it is the “declarations” page displaying all of the coverage limits that we require.

Most insurance agents will be happy to fax or email this page to us upon your request. To make things even easier if you add the marina as “also insured” the insurance company will automatically send it to us each time it is renewed. ## Conditional Moorage Dates

Just a reminder that those of you on the main walkway, F and G docks (conditional moorage areas), are required to vacate your slips for large events in the summer. In 2016 there will be three times that we are requiring you to vacate your slip:

- 4<sup>th</sup> of July: July 1st Vacate by noon  
July 5<sup>th</sup> Return after noon
- WIRW: July 8<sup>th</sup> Vacate by noon  
July 16<sup>th</sup> Return after noon
- Labor Day: Sept. 2<sup>nd</sup> Vacate by noon  
Sept. 5<sup>th</sup> Return after noon

Please vacate your slip by noon and return anytime after noon. The marina will credit your moorage for these dates.
