Hydroplanes

The Oak Harbor Rotary Club will be hosting the "Heroes for Hydroplanes" hydroplane racing event on **August 13 & 14** out in the Oak Harbor Bay.

The races are going to be from about 12:00 – 6:00 each day. The racing will occur about 500' off of the breakwater and the course will run from north to south. It is expected that the course will block the north and south entrances to the marina. There are breaks built into the racing schedule to allow boat traffic to come and go, however, it is difficult to say exactly when these breaks will occur.

The roads to the marina will be open and getting to and from the marina should not be impacted.

There will be some smaller racing boats launching from the marina ramp with the big boats launching from Flintstone Park. The launch ramp will be closed from about 10:00am – 6:00pm each day.

Crabbing & Crab Traps

Just a reminder, **crab traps cannot be left unattended on the docks**. Any crab traps found on the docks will be placed on the owner's boat or moved to one of the marina's storage sheds. In either case there will be a minimum labor charge of \$46.30 for Marina Staff to move any unattended crab pots off of the docks.
