



MARINA INFORMATION AND RULES

• Marina Office is open: *7 days a week from March through October*

- The office is closed and the marina is unattended on Sundays and legal holidays November – February.
- Marina office and Fuel dock will be closed for lunch from noon to 1, October through the end of April.

Fuel dock closes 30 minutes prior to marina closing time.

- Marina office monitors **channel 16 VHF**, and uses **channel 68 VHF** as a working channel.
- Moorage may be paid at the pay stations located in the booth at **slip F-27** and at the entrance to the Marina office. Utilize the guest moorage envelopes and drop boxes provided. Moorage may also be paid in the Marina office during business hours.
- All vessels remaining for more than **2 hours** or past business hours are required to pay moorage.
- Checkout time is **NOON**.
- Key cards are required for operation of the outside gate after Marina operating hours. Keys are provided in the Marina office.
- **OAK HARBOR YACHT CLUB** maintains reciprocal moorage May 1 – September 15, **side tie at G-02**, for use by members of yacht clubs having reciprocal privileges. These slips are available on a first come, first served basis, with a maximum length of stay of 48 hours. Utilization of moorage elsewhere in the Marina requires payment of moorage fees.
- **No** open fires on docks. Barbecue apparatus designed for use on boats is acceptable.
- **No** fireworks on Marina property.
- Pets are welcome, but must be on a leash or carried. Immediate and proper cleanup and disposal of animal waste is required. **Grassy Pet Area beyond booth at slip F-27**.
- Riding of bicycles, motorbikes, skateboards or roller blades on floats is prohibited.
- Observe no wake zones. **No** vessels under sail inside the Marina.
- **No** swimming, water skiing or operation of jet skis within the Marina.
- Diving within the Marina is prohibited except for authorized divers working on vessels or floats.
- **No** posting of unauthorized signs or distribution of flyers, brochures, etc., on Marina property.
- **Please** be considerate of your neighbors. Behavior which disturbs or creates a nuisance for others is prohibited.
- Place all trash in dumpsters located in main parking lot, or in trash cans provided on the breakwater dock. Use recycling facilities where applicable. Access to waste oil/ antifreeze/filter/bilge water containers is available from the Marina office.
- Boat hoist is to be operated only by marina staff. **NO WORK** is to be done on boats suspended in the hoist.
- **NO WORK ON BOATS** is permitted which causes discharge of pollutants/contaminants into the water. This includes sanding dust, paint, petroleum products, chemical cleaners which are not classified as biodegradable, dirty bilge water, and boat sewage. Compliance with Marina environmental policy is required. See Marina office for a copy.
